**Responsibilities:**

Under the guidance of the Head of sub-office, the UNV will:

- Work with the programme unit in the Gaza sub-office to ensure that HIV/AIDS is considered in the design and implementation of all projects (mainstreaming or direct implementation);
- Identify and/or design new projects, in co-operation with relevant Provincial Government structures and cooperating partners;
- Negotiate Field Level Agreement with partners
- Identify training needs of government counterparts and cooperating partners and participate in planning and implementation of training;

- Work with co-operating partners – national and international NGOs, faith-based organizations, community-based organisations – to build their capacity in handling the food aid component of their projects;
- Ensure adequate monitoring, reporting and evaluation of WFP projects, with special attention on HIV/AIDS, and impact of nutrition within these projects:
- Ensure that timely and adequate reports are prepared and disseminated to Country Office:
- Ensure compliance with WFP's policies, criteria and procedures with respect to food aid;
- Act as a focal point for HIV/AIDS related issues in the office;
- Liaise with Provincial and district government counterparts working in the field of HIV/AIDS, OVCs and health.
- Design and maintain a data base on HIV/AIDS projects;

**Required Qualifications and Experience:**

- Must be an Italian citizen, as this is position that is fully-funded by the Government of Italy;
- Good analytical skills;
- Good interpersonal skills;
- High level of knowledge on HIV/AIDS
- Knowledge or experience of food security and nutrition is desirable
- Ability to manage staff and establish effective working relationships with staff, government counterparts and partners;
